



# Ronnie Gardiner Method Fundraising Foundation (RGMFF)

## Statutes

1. The purpose of the foundation is to spread the training method Ronnie Gardiner Method (RGM) so that it becomes available to more people and can contribute to the physical, cognitive, and mental health of both adults and children, with or without disabilities. Support activities with the aim of promoting, introducing, and maintaining RGM in the countries where RGM has license agreements with RGM leaders. Promote and support initiatives regarding scientific research on the effects and experiences of RGM. Develop and market new target groups that benefit from the training method. Responsibility for entering into license agreements with RGM leaders that include how to use and protect RGM as a method and how to apply for funds from the foundation. Protect the RGM from improper use.
2. The foundation shall be managed by a board which shall consist of at least three (3) and at most six (6) members. Alternates can be appointed. Board members term of office is one (1) year, respectively two (2) years. Reelection can take place.
3. The foundation's purpose is promoted through the return in the form of interest income and dividends.
4. The foundation's assets must be acceptably invested so that good real value growth and a long-term sustainable return can be achieved.
5. The board has its seat in Nyköping, Sweden.
6. The foundation's financial year is a calendar year.
7. The board's management and the foundation's accounts must be audited annually by an approved or authorized auditor. A deputy must be appointed. The auditor and deputy are appointed by the board for a period of one (1) year with the possibility of re-election. The annual report must be submitted to the auditor for review no later than four months after the end of the financial year. The auditors must submit its audit report no later than five and a half months after the end of the foundation's financial year. The annual report with the audit report is submitted to the County Administrative Board for registration no later than six months after the end of the financial year.
8. The intention is that scholarships of a certain size will be awarded. Funds from RGMFF are intended for direct support to the applicant. The foundation does not cover indirect costs (so-called "overhead") or administrative fees that may be charged by an intermediary organization or institution. This means that scholarships from the foundation must go directly to the applicant without being reduced by external administration fees. When the application is approved, the foundation requests a short report from the applicant to verify that the funds have been used in accordance with the foundation's purpose within two years of the grant being granted.
9. The foundation must be under supervision according to The law of Foundations.
10. Amendments to these statutes may be made by a unanimous board without permission from the authority. However, changes to the purpose and this point may not take place without permission from the competent authority.
